CHAPLAIN STEVE BROWN**

Chaplain Brown, a Michigan native, began his military career by enlisting in the United States Marine Corps Reserve in 1980. While serving, he returned to Bob Jones Seminary to complete his Master of Divinity degree. In 1987 CAPT



Brown superseded to active duty in the Navy Chaplain Corps. He served in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, Saudi Arabia and Kuwait during Operations Desert Shield and Storm, NYC providing ministry at Ground Zero, VA, and OH. He served as senior "Seabee" chaplain from 2007-2010 before being deployed again to Afghanistan. He has received several personal decorations and medals.

CAPT Brown retired in 2013 after almost 33 years of active and reserve Navy and Marine Corps service. He has assumed responsibilities as the President of Associated Gospel Churches located in Greenville, SC. AGC currently endorses 100 active duty and reserve military chaplains.
