Peniel Bible Camp

Peniel Bible Camp is a 360 acre camp located at the end of a long, quiet country lane in central Ohio. Rolling meadows and woods surround two beautiful lakes. Activities including hiking, basketball, volleyball, horseshoes, disc golf, tennis, swimming, fishing, canoeing, riflery, archery, or just sitting and visiting.

Peniel Bible Camp is located three miles from the intersection of Interstate 71 and Ohio Route 95 (about 40 miles north of Columbus). From I-71, take State Route 95 (exit 151) east into Chesterville. At the stoplight in town, turn right on State Route 314. The camp is located on the right, one mile south of Chesterville.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING: Bible, pencil or pen, overnight items, bedding (sheets and blankets) or sleeping bag.

DO NOT BRING: Tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, two-piece swimsuits, T-shirts with worldly advertising or tank tops.
