



## YOUTH CAMP INFORMATION

### Check-in:

Check-in is from 2:00 to 3:00 PM on Monday. Upon arrival at camp, campers should go to *Ashbrook Hall*. Each camper should have a completed **Medical Form** (if not previously mailed to the camp), all **medications**, the balance of the **camp fee**, and **spending money**. After check-in, campers will be directed to the cabin area where counselors will help them settle into their assigned cabins.

### Medical Needs:

During check-in each camper will have the opportunity to discuss any specific physical needs with the Camp Nurse. A completed and signed Medical Form (enclosed) is required of each camper. Although a medical examination is not required for camp, we remind you of the advisability of having a physical examination if there is any reason to suspect that the camper is having medical problems. It is also recommended that each camper have a current tetanus booster before coming to camp. All medications will be turned over to the camp nurse as they are not allowed in the cabins. Medications should be in the original container and labeled with the camper's name. Campers do not need to bring common over-the-counter medications unless they are taken on a regular basis.

### Camp Store and Spending Money:

All money will be turned in and recorded on a Camp Store card. No money is allowed in the cabins. The camper will have access to his card when the Camp Store is open during the week. Purchases made in the Camp Store, as well as the camp offering (which is taken during the week for a specific ministry), will be deducted from the card. Money not spent will be returned on Saturday morning. The Camp Store sells pop, fruit juices, candy, ice cream, Bibles, books, gift items, some toiletry items, and Peniel Bible Camp clothing. The Camp Store will be open Monday afternoon during check-in for cash sales only.

Please have your camper double check for anything left behind when leaving. **Lost and Found** items will only be kept for two weeks after the end of your camp.
